First: Support for families Program

The total amount spent during 2010 for the families who have lost their supporter, or have no steady income, was L.E.1141785.-- caring for 1195 families each month .

Second: Health care & Disabilities Assistance Program

In 2010, an amount of L.E. 4770785.05 has been spent as follows:

Third: Education Assistance Program

Throughout 2010, BLESS spent a sum of L.E. 454946.-- as follows:

- ✠ The assistance relevant to the academic year expenses for 3678 students was in the amount of L.E. 413796.-- all year round.*
- ✠ Monthly assistance for 242 students during the study months totaling L.E.41150.—*

The assistance for the girls (of God's brethren) to be married during 2010, was in the amount of L.E.2635436.-- targeting 2329 girls .

❖ **I. St. Verena Service (Great Cairo Region)**

Throughout 2010, many families have been served in the poor & disadvantaged areas in Great Cairo region where we serve our elder & sick fathers and mothers who are incapable of going to the Church to speak about their needs.

The services include: curative services, health awareness, house restoration, daily living assistance in addition to the diakonal service in the following areas:

Shark El seka El Hadid (El Hekr & Mahmasha) - Madent El Nour(El Gandoul & El Kharta El Gedida) - Hadek El Koba (El Shouna & Ezbet Abu hashesh) – Ain Shams(Ezbet Atef & Ezbet Maarof) - Ezbet El Nakhal(El Zehour & Arab Eltawila) – El Marg (El Falaha & el Shawafaa)- El Khosos (El Ghafeer & El Maagen) – Moasest El zakah(Houd Gala)– Abo Regila – Shoubra(Ezbet Girgis & Abo El Farag) - Shoubre El Khima(Om Baioumy, Bahteim , El qatawy, El Amal & Bigam) - El Moatamadia (El zaraib & Ezbet hkeza) - Imbaba (Ard hadad & El kasr) - El Warak - Geziret El Warak –Fisal (El Manshia & Eltarabie) – Helwan(Arab Salam) .

❖ **II : Seven Deacons Service (Serving Coptic minorities who live in remote villages and hamlets)**

A. The main objective of the **Seven Deacons service** is to meet the basic needs of these Coptic minorities who live in remote villages and hamlets like : pure drinking water connections, sewage disposal (or pit latrines), roof construction, wall and floor repair , installing doors and windows, etc..

B. In addition to the above mentioned services there are spiritual and health services, assistance given for treatment and marriage , literacy classes , economic development youth and children activities, monthly assistance for widows and

old people. All these services contitute what we avove listed under " Other assistance".


